Thank you for choosing us as your bathtub supplier

We hope the bathtub will give you many lovely baths and pleasant moments.

For the best conditions for lifelong durability, we recommend that you read through the user manual before you start using it new bathtubs. This user manual applies to the Brilliant bathtub and will describe what is important to consider before, during and after your bath.



RECEIPT OF DELIVERY

Check that no transport damage has occurred during delivery, if it has, contact your seller directly. Lift off the lid and then remove all cartons and loose parts from the tub.

Then fold the bathtub down so that it stands with the bottom on the ground. Remove the conveyor belts, the pallet and the protective packaging.

Check that all the following parts are included:

- Gas heater
- Assembly trolley for the gas heater
- Drainage and sewage sludge
- Mounted hoses
- Reduction valve for the gas tube is not included.

Then lift the bathtub into place, (recommended 2-3 people for lifting, alternatively use a lifting crane or similar aids) grab under the panel when lifting. The bathtub cannot be rolled.

Make sure people who lift are in good physical condition and use good lifting technique. If you have had problems with your back in the past, you should avoid this heavy lifting.

Before you fill the bathtub with water for the first time, it should be rinsed and is wiped out as assembly dust and dirt often remain after assembly in the factory.

The bathtub must be placed on a flat level and firm surface.

INSTALLATION OF THE BATHTUB

- 1. Mount the four clamps to the lid with the included screws. The code for the lid is 00. It cannot be changed.
- 2. Read the separate manual for the gas trolley to motor the heater and trolley and also to start the bath.

MAINTENANCE

THE BATHTUB

- The plastic is wiped clean with a wet cloth and a little mild detergent without surfactants if necessary.
- Clean the filter for the gas heater after every bath.
- The bathtub's panel is treated with an iron vitrol, which will give your bathtub a beautiful shade of gray over the years.

THE BATH WATER

We recommend our customers, who do not have a bath equipped with a purification system, to change the bath water between each bathing occasion. If you do not have the opportunity to do this and choose to use the bath water more than once, there are some simple tricks to maintain good water hygiene.

- Always shower before going into the bath to avoid the bath water being contaminated with sun lotion and skin particles, this should also be done when using a purifier.
- Add bactericides. It is important to never add a chlorine-based agent (or other disinfectants with corrosive content) as chlorine is not good for the skin, the environment or the bathtub. We recommend the chlorine-free disinfectant BioCool. Dosing is done easily according to the instructions on the bottle. Pool disinfection should also be used if a treatment plant is used.

The above advice increases the possibility of using the bathing water on more than one bathing occasion. Remember that circumstances such as weather conditions, the number of bathing occasions and the number of bathers are decisive for how long the bathing water can be kept hygienic.

SALTWATER

It is not possible to use salt water in the bathtub.

WINTER USE

When you have finished bathing during the winter, you must empty the water from your bath. You must also ensure that the water flows out of the hoses so that they do not freeze. The gas heater and the gas must be stored in a frost-free area when not in use. no guarantees apply when water is left in at subzero temperatures as there is a high risk of something freezing.

If it is very cold outside, it is also important to keep an eye on the gas heater while it is heating, if, for example, the gas runs out or freezes during heating, the gas heater will stop, and there is a risk that the hoses will freeze if you do not have the gas heater under supervision.

IMPORTANT!

- Read the gas heater's separate instruction sheet before use.
- Never leave children unattended in the bathtub.
- Always check the water temperature before you or someone else jumps into the bath.
- The water coming out of the gas heater can be very hot, be careful not to burn yourself or someone else.
- Make sure that no unauthorized person can get into the bath without your knowledge.
